JARDIM DE GUERRA (WAR GARDEN)

Set in Rio de Janeiro under the military dictatorship in the 1960s, JARDIM DE CUERRA follows a young leftist Edson and his love interest, aspiring filmmaker Maria. The film takes a dark turn when Edson, in an attempt to raise fast money for Maria's film, is baselessly arrested and tortured for his suspected involvement in a plot to overthrow the regime.

MANGUE BANGUE

The silent film loosely follows a stockbroker as he devolves into a primitive creature that raves between Rio de Janeiro's financial center and Mangue, the neighboring red-light district, before disappearing into the jungle.
